**This scholarship is awarded based on the following criteria:**

- **must be a North Carolina resident who plans to enroll in Surry Community College.**
- **must pursue a Bachelor's Degree in Education upon graduation.**
- **may be a high school senior with a 3.0 GPA.**
- **may be a rising college sophomore with a 3.0 GPA for the prior academic year.**
- **must write a Personal Statement of 300 words answering the question: "If teaching is the art of assisting discovery, what qualities or insights do you believe you will need to be an effective teacher?"**

**The scholarship awarded is for \$500.00 on a per semester basis and can be renewed, for the second semester, contingent upon academic performance. Poor scholastic performance will negate scholarship eligibility.**

**Scholarship recipient shall be selected by the Financial Aid Office of Surry Community College.**

**Trinette H.Kirkman, President of the Joseph Roy Kirkman Foundation, or her designee, will evaluate the personal statement as part of the selection process.**
