## **NC Association of School Resource Officers Student Scholarship**

**Purpose:** This scholarship fund was established by the Board of Directors of the NC Association of School Resource Officers (NCASRO) in 2018. Eligible students must be entering an accredited and recognized two or four-year University. Strong consideration will be given to financial need but scholastic standing will also be very important, along with participation in extra-curricular activities, personal reputation, and moral integrity within the standards of NCASRO.

**Criteria:** The students eligible for assistance must be graduating high school seniors who reside in North Carolina. The applicant must have a minimum of a 2.5 grade point average (non-weighted). Verification of the GPA must be submitted with application. The applicant must submit a video message on a DVD on what their plans are during and after college. The video message should be at least two minutes in length.

**Guidelines:** Scholarship will be awarded on an annual basis and disbursed to the college the student will be attending. The applicant must explain any extracurricular activities they participate in and out of school (ie, SADD Club, Sports, Youth or Church Groups, Community Involvement etc). Applicant must submit letters of recommendation from School Resource Officer, one past or current teacher or school official.

**Amount:** The scholarship award will be a onetime of \$500.00 that will be paid directly to the school the student will be attending.

**Deadline:** The application deadline is May 1, 2019.
